All Rights Reserved- Why and How to Copyright Your Website ...

All rights reserved. This line of text notifies others that the work is protected by copyright; it identifies the owner/creator of the work and lists the year of first publication. (First publication can be the first time the work was written down and distributed, even if it's written on a napkin or scrap of paper).

How to write a \u00a9 copyright notice and why to use it? \u2013 IP ...

This statement tells the public what rights you are reserving for yourself. For example, you could write "All Rights Reserved" if you don't want to allow anyone to copy your work, "Some Rights Reserved" for a creative commons license, or "No Rights Reserved" if you want to give all rights away. The only elements required on a copyright page are the copyright notice itself: And some statement giving notice that the rights to reproduce the work are reserved to the copyright holder. All Rights Reserved. Next you'll see two versions of the copyright page, one long page with a CIP data block and a short version.

Copyright Page Samples You Can Copy and Paste Into Your Book

Copyright covers both published and unpublished works. In the United States copyright law is based on the Copyright Act of 1976. The law gives authors of original works exclusive rights to the works and the option to grant usage rights to others. In other words it declares who owns creative work, like design, text (copy), images and even source code.

How to Properly Copyright[] a Website - Legal & HTML ...

Microsoft products and services—including images, text, and software downloads (the "content")—are owned either by Microsoft Corporation or by third parties who have granted Microsoft permission to use the content. Microsoft cannot grant you permission for content that is owned by third parties.

Use of Microsoft Copyrighted Content | Intellectual Property

If you use a Creative Commons License, you likely already have this on your site but may want to further clarify with "Some Rights Reserved". Finally, if you want to give all rights away, simply say "No Rights Reserved" and offer a clear dedication to the public domain.

Currently, copyright applies for an extreme term of life plus 50 or more years in almost every country. Only a handful of countries don't offer protection to foreign works - almost all countries respect copyright. When a work's copyright term finally ends, the work passes into the public domain - becomes free to everyone.

Copyright notices on websites - Copyright Agency

The humble copyright notice is always useful to show in the footer, as a way of stating your claim over a site. Interestingly, however, it is not required for you to have copyright over the graphics, content, and artwork of your site. This comes into place as soon as you've created the content and placed it in the public domain.
