inability of localising and treating all the canals of the root canal system. Root canal systems are commonly complex with the teeth often having lateral ramifications, extra roots or additional canals. Molar and premolar teeth can present with the highest incidence of aberrant morphology. A thorough knowledge of expected anatomy and variations from the norm are essential when undertaking root canal therapy to ensure success.

A root canal is the naturally occurring anatomic space within the root of a tooth. It consists of the pulp chamber (within the coronal part of the tooth), the main canal (s), and more intricate anatomical branches that may connect the root canals to each other or to the surface of the root.

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The median canal diameter at 1, 2, and 5 mm from the apex for the palatal canal was: 0.29, 0.40, and 0.55 mm, respectively, buccally and lingually, and 0.33, 0.40, 0.74 mm mesially and distally [1]. The palatal canal is unique, wide, and rectilinear except for a slight curvature in order of 0.23–0.12 mm ?1 [29].

The root canal cross-sectional morphology in maxillary first premolars is complicated, including round, oval, long oval, flat canal, and irregular canal shapes. 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Root canal configuration of the mesial root revealed 2 canals in 94.4% and 3 canals in 2.3%. The most common canal system configuration was Vertucci type IV (52.3%), followed by type II (35%). Root canal configuration of the distal root revealed type I configuration in 62.7%, followed by types II (14.5%) and IV (12.4%).
